

## RECREATION AND PARKS ADVISORY BOARD COACHES TRAINING POLICY

1. The Rutgers Youth Sports Council should remain the township recognized means of instructing volunteer coaches.
2. Any coach who attends or has attended a Coaches Safety Clinic will be considered grandfathered for life and will not have to revisit a volunteer clinic program, unless a second program is provided by the Rutgers Youth Sports Council.
3. If a second program is provided by the Rutgers Youth Sports Council, coaches will be required to take this follow up course on the later of
  - (a.) Four (4) years from when they took the first course; or
  - (b.) One year from when that new course becomes available.

The RPAB require all sports organizations to provide a list of current coaches annually along with the date of each coach's certification and the number of years the individual has coached as part of their grant application. Organizations should be advised in advance that this is going to be required as part of their grant process.
